## **Academic Year / Term Program General Terms & Behavior Agreement 2021/2022**

All Equinox Education Services programmes promote cultural exchange, which requires the willingness to learn and adapt to with understanding and appreciation the customs of the culture community and hosting environment, which may be very well different from one's own.

I confirm that my son/daughter is mature enough to handle independent international travel and cross-cultural adjustment.

Equinox Education Services Academic Term/Year programme is open to students of all nationalities aged between 12-18.

All information supplied on the application form must be accurate. Equinox Education Services does not tolerate any form of anti-social behaviour- including bullying which includes cyber bullying, racism, lying, theft, physical or verbal harassment or assault.

Students found to be in breach of these conditions may well be sent home depending on the seriousness of the Violation.

I understand that my son/daughter must follow Irish law and that in no circumstances can they take illegal substances including alcohol.

I understand that Equinox Education Services policy is not to allow students to attend any discos , house parties etc that are not supervised by Equinox Education Services or their school . In the interest of child safety this rule can not be over turned by natural parents.

Host Family Accommodation Host families will provide suggestions, support and assistance, but are not tour guides or taxi services.

Host families should not be treated as hotels, I understand that I must be willing to interact and communicate with the host family. Integration into the host families' lives varies case by case. Students should feel like a true member of the family.

I agree to reimburse hosts for any damage made to their property.

I understand that I may be placed in single-person household, households without children at home, etc. Placements are not restricted based on any local characteristics, such as regional accents or dialects, ethnic character of community, types of industry, economy, weather etc. Equinox Education Services do not discriminate against race, creed or religion.

I understand that in the event of discontent with my son/daughter's Host family that all complaints should be directed through my local agent or Equinox Education Services guardian. Under no circumstances will I make contact with the Irish host family directly to make a complaint about them.

I understand that my son / daughter will not be allowed to travel unaccompanied outside of their local area unless written permission and consent form is sent to Equinox Education Services.

I understand that (unless in case of emergency) my son/daughter will not change host family in the first month of arrival to allow time for them to settle and for the Equinox Education Services team to resolve any issues or misunderstandings.

Health & Medical Information All students must divulge all medical complaints/ requirements prior to their arrival in Ireland. If students are found to be unable to complete the programme due to any medical or social problem Equinox Education Services reserves the right to refuse student enrolment in the high school programme.

All costs related to academic student's medical or dental care are the responsibility of the parents.

All parents must consent to medical treatment under the Guardianship of Equinox Education Services in the event of a medical emergency .
